



Minimum Physical Standards for Exported Fishery Products		
Attributes	Criteria	
1. Net content	<u>Defective</u> : -	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : - The average net content in a sample from the production run of pre-packed articles is not less than the stated quantity marked on the packages and - The total number of prepackages in the sample is more than tolerable deficiency does not exceed the acceptance number and - None of the prepackages in the sample is more than twice the prescribed tolerable deficiency.
2. Presentation/Product Identity	<u>Defective</u> : A unit will be considered defective when any presentation of product is not according to the product description.	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : The total number of sample units found defective for standards of presentation, does not exceed the acceptance number.
3. Foreign Matter	<u>Defective</u> : A unit will be considered defective when any matter, which has not been derived from the product, and does not pose a threat to human health are found.	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : - The total number of defect does not exceed the acceptance number and - There is no only one critical foreign matter, pose a threat to human health.
4. Container Integrity	<u>Defective</u> : A unit will be considered defective when abnormal container characteristics are found.	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : - The total number of minor defect does not exceed the acceptance number and - There is no only one serious defect.



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5. Sensory Quality	<u>Defective</u> : A sample unit affected by persistent and distinct objectionable odors or flavors indicative of decomposition or rancidity.	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : The total number of defect does not exceed the acceptance number.
6. Labelling	<u>Defective</u> : -	<u>Lot acceptance</u> : Labeling requirements or regulations of country destination are found.
